

PUBLIC PERFORMANCE BY STUDENTS

The Board of Directors recognizes that student participation in civic and community affairs is educationally beneficial to students. Therefore, the Board encourages student participation at public performances, provided such performances contribute to the educational processes and objectives of the school, and provided they do not unduly interfere with students' program.

The following guidelines apply:

1. All performances shall be approved by the immediate administrator;
2. The extended use of one particular group should be discouraged;
3. Extensive travel by any one particular group should be discouraged;
4. Student groups below the senior high school level should engage in public activities on a very limited scale only; and
5. Game nights using play money require prior approval by the Board.
