

STUDENT BASIC SKILL GOALS

1. To achieve a mastery of the fundamental learning skills especially the skills in reading, writing, speaking, listening, mathematics, reasoning, studying, and technological literacy while gaining a broad, general education and to establish personal standards of educational excellence.
2. To understand and appreciate this country's democratic heritage and acquire the skills, knowledge, understanding, values, and attitudes necessary to participate in democratic self-government.
3. To understand and use technology and its related developments.
4. To develop the ability to use personal and public resources wisely and to learn to be a good manager of money, property and resources.

OTHER STUDENT GOALS

1. To develop a commitment to lifelong learning.
2. To understand and believe in oneself; to accept personal responsibility for one's education and personal development; and to develop good character and self-respect while building a system of moral standards and spiritual values which contribute to a democratic society.
3. To develop positive attitudes toward and skills for work and an appreciation of the social value and dignity of work and to develop pride in the student's own work.
4. To understand and respect ethnic and cultural differences and work effectively with other individuals and groups.
5. To develop understanding of the global nature of society and the interdependence of the world's people.
6. To develop and maintain sound physical and mental health.
7. To perceive, judge, and value cultural expressions of humankind and develop skills for personal expression and communication through the arts.
8. To develop worthy leisure-time interests and activities.
