October 28, 2013 **6:30 P.M.**

Coon Rapids-Bayard Board of Directors met in regular session academic/curriculum meeting October 28, 2013 in the Media Center at the Coon Rapids-Bayard Int/Jr.-Sr. High School.

President Davis called the regular meeting to order at 6:30 P.M., Schlatter verified/reviewed the public meeting notice posted in at least three locations (Int/Jr.-Sr. High School Commons-Coon Rapids, IA, News Gazette-Bayard, IA, Coon Rapids Enterprise-Coon Rapids, IA and Coon Rapids Municipal Utilities-Coon Rapids, IA) on October 24, 2013. Principal Jorth reviewed the Professional Learning Communities (PLC) framework and process. The review included Learning Targets including:

- a. Defining PLC;
- b. 3 Big Ideas (Focus on Student Learning, Collaboration, and Focus on Results); and
- c. Examine the 4 Critical Questions (Are Students Learning? How Will I Know They Are Learning? What to Do for Kids That Aren't Learning? What to Do for Kids that Are Learning?)

Principal Jorth also discussed the reading and math academic goals with the Board.

Supt. Stoffers reviewed and shared the District Assessment Plan with the Board. He also shared DOE Site Visit information.
