

## **2014/2015 Annual Improvement Goals:**

### **Reading:**

By the November, 2014 Iowa Assessment testing, the percent of students proficient or above in Reading, using the aggregate total of grades 6-8 from November 2013 will increase for grades 6-8 where 74.8% were proficient.

### **Math:**

By the November, 2014 Iowa Assessment testing, the percent of students proficient or above in Math, using the aggregate total of grades 3-5 from November 2013 will increase for grades 3-5 where 74.1% were proficient.

### **Science:**

By the November, 2014 Iowa Assessment testing, the percent of 10<sup>th</sup> grade students proficient or above in Science, using cohort scores from November, 2013, will increase for grade 9 where 83% were proficient.

### **Social Studies**

By the November, 2014 Iowa Assessment testing, the percent of 9<sup>th</sup> grade students proficient or above in Social Studies will increase for grade 8 where 67.7% were proficient on the Nov., 2013 Social Studies Iowa Assessment Testing.

### **School Environment**

All students in grades K-12 will receive ongoing training in digital literacy beginning the Spring of 2014. Topics include cyberbullying, internet safety, privacy and security, digital footprint and reputation and information literacy.
